Subject:- Recognition of the School.
Sir,

With reference to the correspondence resting with your letter No. Nil dated 2-7-56 on the subject cited above, I have the honour to inform you that the Director of Education has been pleased to accord provisional recognition to your school for 2 academic years ending 30-4-58 on the following conditions:-

1. That the fixed deposit of Rs. 5000/- be got converted into reserve fund in the joint name of the Director of Education and the manager of the School.
2. That untrained and unqualified teachers including Middle J.V./S.V. and superannuated teachers if there is any on the teaching staff should be replaced by trained and qualified ones.
3. That staff employed in the school should be paid in accordance with the prescribed scales of pay and grade etc.
4. That no tuition fees and unauthorised boys' funds should be charged.
5. First primary class of this school should be converted into Basic with immediate effect and the rest of the classes be converted gradually.

The school has been brought on the grant-in-aid list with effect from 2-5-56 and in no case grant will be paid to the untrained and unqualified including Middle J.V./S.V. and superannuated teachers, if any retained by the management.
